Outdoor Patio

Technology Lab

Teaching Kitchen

The Teaching Kitchen will provide the space, tools, and appliances to help teach adults with IDD these essential life skills. Art Room Donation Amount: \$50,000

In the Music Room, adults can learn to play an instrument, sing, take music therapy, or work with a musician visiting the Enrichment Center.

Resource Library Donation Amount: \$50,000

Many families face challenges when trying to find the information they need to navigate their journey toward adulthood and independence for their children with IDD. This Resource Library will be open to the community and will be a place for research and sharing of information between parents, guardians, community partners, teachers, and others that help to support adults with IDD. There will be information about services and activities from other community organizations, including vocational training and job opportunities, and other educational opportunities.

Pickleball Sport Court

Donation Amount: \$150,000

Pickleball is one of the largest growing sports today. It is a sport that can be enjoyed by all ages and physical abilities. Adults learn teamwork, hand-eye coordination, engage in great aerobic exercise, and increase their social skills by playing pickleball. Included with the sport court will be a pergola structure to provide shade, benches, and all the equipment for the various court sports.
